 - 500 hours of Cross Country Time;
 - 100 hours of Night Flight Time;
 - 75 hours of Actual or Simulated Instrument Time, 50 of those hours in actual flight
- Speak and write fluent English.
- FCC Radio Telephone Operators Permit.
- Possess a valid driver's license and either have or be able to obtain valid passport.
- Bachelor's degree a bonus.
- Possess a positive, team-oriented attitude with exceptional communication and computer skills.
- Ability to interact in professional, trustworthy and confidence inspiring manner with clients and internal staff at all levels.
- Possess vision sufficient to perform the functions of this position.
